

## Useful Information

### ☞ How to ride the Limousine Bus from Incheon Int'l Airport to Daejeon Government Complex ([http://bssihy.kasi.re.kr/unbssw1\\_3.aspx](http://bssihy.kasi.re.kr/unbssw1_3.aspx))

1. If you get off the airplane, at first you will find a long and wide corridor to the customs.



2. And you have to pass the customs, it will be simple and take short time



3. After pass the customs then you will find the “Baggage Claim Information” board and find out your baggage



4. And go out to the “BLUE RIBBON” lane and exchange the money



5. If you get out from the custom section, then you have been passed the arrival gate “A”~ “F”



6. Now, find out the information table which is in between gate “A” and “B”
7. Beside the information table, you will find a **guider** who holds a UN BSS & IHY workshop plate in his hand.
8. If you introduce to him your nation and name, then he will guide you how to reach Hotel Riviera.

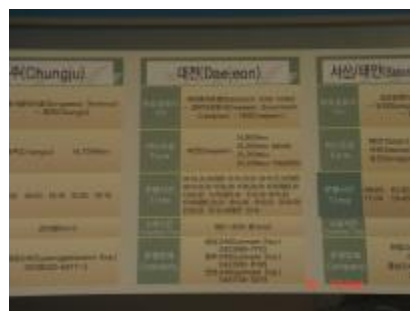


**(Notice) The workshop guider will serve at the Incheon airport from 11:00 to 18:00 on September 20 and 21, 2009.**

9. If you arrive at very early or late and you can't find the workshop guider at the airport, get out the building door No. 8.



10. If you go out through door No.8, you will find the bus ticket booth.



11. Turn to right side as soon as you across the road and go straight 20m then you will find the bus stop. # 9D.



12. Wait there and ride the bus on time. You have to be careful to ride the exact direction to DAEJEON(대전) because many local buses stop here.

13. You have to confirm the direction from bus driver or any Korean peoples or confirm the Red color letter plate in front of the bus window “대전”

It takes 3 hours from Incheon airport to Daejeon. Those limousine buses are non-stop except one time of rest (about 10~15 minutes) at highway resting place. If the bus enter Daejeon city, it will stop 3 times and you have to ride off at the 2nd stop where the bus stop name is “Jung-bu-chung-sa”.

If you take off at 2nd stop, take the taxi and ask to taxi driver “Yu seong Riviera Hotel ga-ju-se-yo”.. It takes about 20 minutes and the charge is about 5000 won (Korean money).

The taxi and limousine bus charge is available only the Korean money.

Also, the organizing committee have prepared the shuttle bus (Van) for your convenience from Daejeon Government Complex (“Jung-bu-chung-sa”) to Riviera Hotel. The shuttle bus schedule is below.

## **General Information**

### **1) About Korea**

Korea, traditionally known as the Land of the Morning Calm, is today a modern, bustling hub of East Asia. It is a peninsula jutting off of China, and Japan is only two hours away. Despite this close physical proximity to the neighboring countries, Korea has a distinctive culture of its own, which has developed during its 5,000 years of history. Visitors can expect to meet a lively population with its own language, writing system, architecture, cuisine, and many other manifestations of a unique cultural heritage.

### **2) Climate & Weather**

Korea's climate is regarded as a continental climate from a temperate standpoint and a monsoon climate from a precipitation standpoint. The climate of Korea is characterized by four distinct seasons. Spring and autumn are rather short, summer is hot and humid, and winter is cold and dry with abundant snowfall. Temperatures differ widely from region to region within Korea, with the average being between 10° C (50F) and 22° C (71.6F). From September autumnal tints arrive nationwide by October. It is the best time to visit Korea for enjoying, be careful weather. During the Workshop, sleeved shirts and jacket would be a good idea.

### **3) Electricity**

In Korea, an outlet for 220 volt is available. Overseas delegates bringing laptop computers and other electrical appliances are advised to check whether a transformer is required.

### **4) Korea travel Phone 1330**

When you need English assistance or travel information, just dial 1330, and a bilingual operation will offer you detailed information on tourist sites, transportation, restaurant, etc. If you want information about areas outside of Seoul, enter the area code of that region before pressing 1330.
